Albany-Marilyn Jean Wade Dumas of Colonie passed peacefully Friday, June 17, 2022.

A lifetime resident with deep family connections to the Capital District, her mother, Elsie, was a member of the Quay family of the Helderberg Hilltowns and her father, Benjamin Wade, a son of a longtime Albany family.

A 1954 graduate of Roessleville High School and Albany Business School, Jean had fond memories of her classmates, attending many of her class reunions. Her career as an administrative assistant/bookkeeper spanned six decades, culminating well beyond typical retirement. She spent the last twenty years of her career as a part time office clerk with the Town of Colonie Highway Department and Latham Water District.
