East Greenbush- Marion C. Hendrick, 91, of East Greenbush peacefully entered eternal life on Sunday, June 15, 2025. Marion grew up in Albany and, attended St. Joseph's Academy. Marion was the beloved daughter of John J. and Catherine M. (Lattimore) Kinsella. She was a devoted wife to her husband of 66 years. She was a loving and supportive Daughter, Mom, Grandmother, Nana, Great-Grandmother (Big Nana and Nene), and Aunt. Marion worked for SEFCU for 26 years before retiring. During her tenure at SEFCU, she worked in the Alfred E. Smith Office Building at the time when only two employees ran that office. Daily upon closing the office, she would take all the transactions for the day up to the State Campus via the United Traction Company's Western Ave bus. It was clearly a different time. She has a contagious laugh which would have everyone laughing along with her even when they did not know why. She loved her children most of all. As a mom she offered unconditional love and guidance with a red paddle when needed. She taught her children to understand the difference between right and wrong, to work hard, to be compassionate to others, to love wholeheartedly and to laugh always. She was proud of their accomplishments, celebrated their successes and mourned their losses. She also applied those values to her grandchildren and great-

grandchildren, minus the red paddle.

Marion was predeceased by her husband, Frank N. Hendrick, Jr. She leaves behind her son, Richard J. Hendrick, Sr. (Mary), her daughters, Linda J. Fylak (Art) and Kathleen A. Hendrick (Ed Yaggle). She is survived by her grandchildren, Keith Pinheiro (Nikki), Sherri Krug (John), Cindy Hendrick (Jeremy Libby), Richard J. Hendrick, Jr. (Stephanie) and Michala Hendrick and eleven great grandchildren.
