Marion was a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Fuller Road Fire Department and Chaplain for many years.

Marion's lifetime was devoted to the care of her husband, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. She loved preparing her mothers and aunts favorite dishes for holidays and special occasions.
