Hutchinson Island, FL- Marion J. Wiczerzak, 85, longtime resident of Albany passed away peacefully Sunday January 25, 2015 in Florida. Born in Rennselaer, NY on August 4, 1929, she was the only child of the late Dr. James Conklin and Margaret Morrissey, wife of the late Walter W. Wiczerzak.
