



Mark Nathaniel Lavery

June 14, 1968 - July 25, 2024

Town of Bolton-Mark Nathaniel Lavery passed away suddenly on July 25, 2024 while boating with family and friends on Lake George, NY. He lived in Clayton, NC for the last two years. He was born on June 14, 1968 at the hospital on Chanute Air Force Base in Illinois. In 1971 Mark moved with his parents to the Capital Region where he grew up. He graduated from Colonie Central High School in 1986. He received both his B.S. and M.S. in Mechanical Engineering from SUNY at Buffalo.

He was happily married to his wife, Sharon (née Roberts) Lavery for over 32 years. Throughout his career, he applied his engineering expertise as a Control Systems Engineer, a Project Manager, and Senior Project Manager at several Fortune 500 companies. Mark was an avid golfer, lego builder, motorcycle enthusiast, Jets fan and marksman. He was a devout Christian, Worship Leader and Head Deacon at the Woodlands Seventh Day Adventist Church. He also regularly attended church services after relocating to North Carolina.

Mark was predeceased by his grandparents Dorothy and Wesley Lavery and Theresa and James Oddy.

He is survived by his wife, Sharon; his children, Alexander (Elise) and Anjolee Lavery.

He is also survived by his parents, Warren and Joyce (née Oddy) Lavery; his brother Brian Lavery (Lisa Aslander); his Aunt Kathy (Raymond Snyder); a host of cousins; a niece and a nephew.
