February 4, 1928 - August 8, 2021

Albany-Martin J. Morrissey, Jr., 93, passed away on August 8, 2021 at his home surrounded by family. He was born in Albany on February 4, 1928 as an only child to Martin J. and Esther Morrissey. As a young boy, he grew up on a farm on Shaker Road and Northern Blvd., where his parents and grandparents were tenant farmers. He then moved to the city of Albany, went to St. Theresa's for elementary school and then on to Vincentian Institute in Albany. After graduation, he joined the Navy.

He worked on a submarine for 2 years and was very proud of his Naval service. He met his wife, Eleanor and they were married for 64 years before she passed in 2013. He spent a long career with New York Telephone Company, starting as a coin collector and ending as an engineer, retiring in 1985. Marty had many health ailments over his lifetime but defied all odds to live into his early 90s. He always maintained a sense of humor through all his obstacles.

He is survived by his four children, Steve (Patricia), Jim (Mimi), and John (Maggie) Morrissey and Patty (Scott) Bateman. He was a grandfather to Stephanie Acquario, Justin and Emily Bateman, Matt (Jen) Morrissey, Sara (Matthew) Salerno, Lindsey and Jamie Morrissey, and Lisa (Cole) Carter.
