Albany-Marvin J. Kenneally Jr, 68, passed away at home Wednesday, December 29, 2010. Born in Albany, he was the son of the late Marvin and Veronica Andress Kenneally. Mr. Kenneally graduated from Vincentian Institute, attended East Texas State University and Idaho State University. He had worked at LaSalle School in Albany, and retired from Vanderheyden Hall in Troy. Marv was known as the 'lunch cop' at St . John the Evangelist Elementary School. He enjoyed spending time with friends and family. He was a member of the Polish American Community Center, a Pioneer Partner with the Verizon Telcom Pioneers. and volunteered for many community projects.

He was the dear husband of Elizabeth Kenneally; father of Timothy Kenneally, Courtney Kenneally (John Maloney) , Kathleen Clough (Eric) and Michael Kenneally; grandfather of Finnegan and Grace Veronica; brother of Colin Kenneally (Susan).

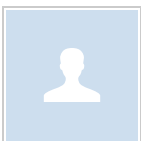
