Mary graduated from St. Joseph's Academy and Memorial Hospital School of Nursing. She worked at Memorial Hospital for many years, and then spent 40 years working alongside her husband, Dr. Anthony T. Capello, in his medical practice. Mary was a member of The Greatest Generation, who proudly served her country in the US Army during WW II.
