Loudonville, NY– Mary Pat Metzger, 93, of Loudonville, entered into eternal life on Wednesday December 30, 2020 at home, surrounded by her loving family. She was the daughter of the late John J. and Anne Dollard Hans. Mary Pat was born in Albany on March 17, 1927 and lived in the area all her life. She is predeceased by her husband of 62 years, Joseph R. Metzger Jr., who passed in October 2018.

Mary Pat was a graduate of Vincentian Institute and attended the College of St. Rose. She then worked for the New York State Teachers' Association. In her 20's, Mary Pat was a member of The Headliners quartet, performing locally in various clubs, radio, and television, sometimes with the swing band of her future husband, Joe Metzger, who she married in 1956. In her later years, she enjoyed golfing in women's leagues at Mill Road and Town of Colonie. She was active for many years in the church choir at St. Pius X, where she was a parishioner for 64 years.

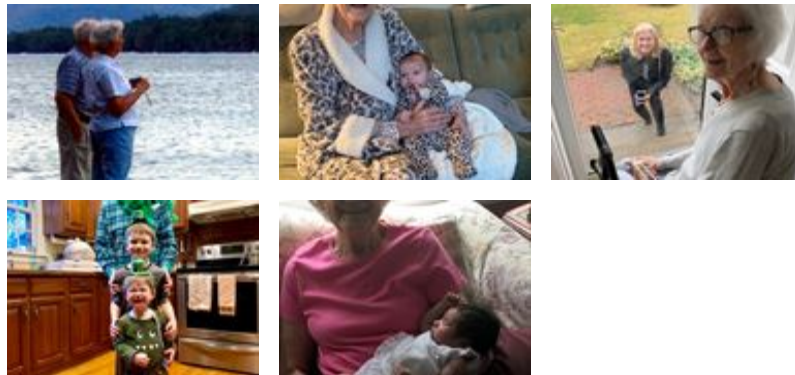
