February 7, 1932 - March 29, 2010

Albany-Mary D. Pearson, 78, died Monday, March 29, 2010 at the Southwestern Vermont Medical Center, Bennington, VT. Born in Albany, she was the daughter of the late Francis and Elizabeth Snyder Dyer.

After being widowed at the age of 28 with four children to raise, Mary pursued an education at the Albany College of Pharmacy, where she was affectionately known as 'Ma Pearson.' Following a brief career in retail Pharmacy, she was employed by the NYS Department of Health to compile the "Green Book" for FDA approved generic prescriptions.

She was the wife of the late George A. Pearson, Sr (1928-1961); mother of Andrew P. Pearson (Millie Daley), Robert F. Pearson (Carol), Alice P. Gavin (Edward), George A. Pearson Jr (Lydia) and late infant daughter, Mary E. Pearson (1962); sister of John Dyer, Robert Dyer, Catherine D. Payne and the late Margaret D. Leonhardt; survived by 12 grandchildren, 7 great grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.
