Albany- Matthew E. Wozniak, 96, died June 16, 2015 at Saint Peter's Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. He was the son of the late Franciszek and Helen Toniacka Wozniak. He was the beloved brother of the late Irene Calka (John) and late Helena G. Maciorowski (Anthony).

Matthew served in the Asia-Pacific theatre during WWII as a chart and mapmaker for the US Army-Air force. After the war, he met his wife, Helen, at a USO dance in Albany. They married in 1948, built a house in Colonie, and raised a family. Matt had a long career as a woodworker and general contractor. He also worked for Terminal Millworks Inc. retiring in 1984. He was a founding member of St. Michael's Episcopal Church in Colonie where he helped to build most everything in it, including the pews and the frames for the stained glass windows. When his boys were young he was active in Boy Scouts.

Matthew is survived by his wife of 66 years, Helen Quade Wozniak and his children Laura Face (Glen); Paul Wozniak (Lynn-Marie Sattler) and Alan Wozniak (Margaret Dano). He has 6 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.
