Michael William Kindlon, 67, of Ravena, New York, passed away July 29, 2020 after a long battle with heart disease. His loving family was at his side.

He and Wendy were always together, life partners and best friends. They took Sunday rides, just because he liked heading for wherever the road took them and just loved spending the day talking and being together. He showered her with so much love.

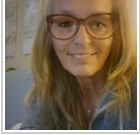

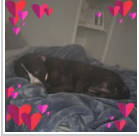

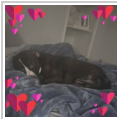
