



Michael A. Nardolillo

August 31, 1928 - April 2, 2014

Albany-Michael A. Nardolillo, 85, died April 2, 2014. Born in Albany to Graziano and Maria Savino Nardolillo, he was predeceased by his brother Nicholas Nardillo, his sister Philomena, his twin Marie Josephine St. Louis, and by his first wife Eleanor Garfield.

Mike graduated from Schuyler High School, Siena College and Boston College Graduate School of Social Work. In his long career as a social worker, he was employed by Albany County Welfare Department, Schenectady Community Action Program, LaSalle School, Catholic Charities and Trinity Institution. He was a US Army veteran.

He served as a volunteer leader in community organizations including the Italian American Community Center, Hope House, Sons of Italy, the Interfaith Task Force of the Roman Catholic Diocese and Albany County Opportunity, Inc. He was the recipient of many awards including Siena College's Professor Egon Plager Award for Humanitarian Effort and the City of Albany Human Rights Award.

He is survived by his loving wife, Janet (Biesemeyer) Nardolillo, sons Michael (Susan) Nardolillo and Mark (Joel Bettinger) Nardolillo, and daughters Elaine (James) Burns, Jenifer Nardolillo, Kara Nardolillo, and Kim (Erick) Burt. 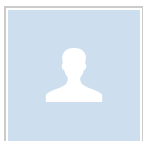
