Guilderland-Michael F. LaFrank Sr passed away peacefully at home Monday, February 14, 2011. Born in Cohoes, he was the son of the late Joseph and Helen English LaFrank. He was a US Army WW II veteran, serving in the European Theater.

Mr. LaFrank worked 46 years with Niagara Mohawk, with his last position as Supervisor of the electrical planning department. He retired in 1986, spending summers in Guilderland and winters in Sarasota, FL. Mike was a lifelong New York Giants fan, and rooted for his beloved Notre Dame Football for the past 82 years.
