June 5, 1988 - April 17, 2020

Colonie-Nicholas Scalia, age 32, passed away unexpectedly on April 17, 2020. Nick was raised in Colonie, NY and was a graduate of The Pathway School in Norristown PA, Class of 2008.

At the time of his passing, he lived in Broadalbin, NY with his fiancé and the love of his life, Shannon Lea Smith.

Nick was a gifted athlete. At eight months, he was running- he never walked. At three years, he was riding a bike without training wheels. He grew to be six feet four inches tall, highly articulate and powerfully built, with a daredevil's approach to biking and skateboarding, and an upbeat, positive attitude toward life and its challenges, large and small. Most of all, he was an exceptionally affectionate and caring child, traits he sustained with great joy all of his days, to the great delight of his family and friends. He had a big laugh and a big heart.

In addition to Shannon, the great passion of his life was fly fishing, at which he was expert. A very active man, with a need to be on the move and doing something physical nearly all the time, Nick found peace and contentment in

that sport. Ankle or hip deep in the waters of a stream or lake, Nick would remain there, casting and casting for hours at a time, moving only to find a more inviting spot. He was a certified New York State Fly Fishing Guide and was planning on opening his own business so he could show others how to do the thing he so loved. He and Shannon lived only a short walk to Sacandaga Lake, and they hiked and fished in their beloved Adirondacks as often as possible.

Nick is survived by his mother, Kathleen Franklin (Kevin Mednick), his brother, Chris Pfielsticker, his father, Joseph Scalia, Jr. (Rita); his grandfather Joseph Scalia, his stepsisters Jennifer Miller (Dan); Alissa Earle (Adam); his stepbrother Kevin Earle (Kelly), his uncle Philip Scalia (Lynn), his cousin Anthony Scalia and his childhood friend Dave Pulcher. Nick was a personality like no other.

He will be sorely missed by all who knew him.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, there will be a private service. A memorial to celebrate Nick's life will be held at a later date.

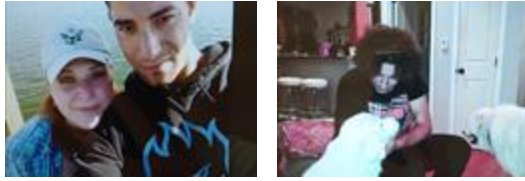

“ There is a lot of absolutely tragic things that have happened to me just before and since Nick's death. Horrendous crimes that are continuing, and the police are refusing to do their jobs. I have been stolen from, not only personal items, but theft of services, my stimulus checks and STAR tax checks, my mail including bank cards and statements. I made reports which are not being handled appropriately. The postmaster illegally gave my mail to someone whose name she refused to tell me, stating that a mail carrier named Suzanne told her that she knew me and the woman who received it, however, I do not know any one named Suzanne or any of the mail carriers. Massive corruption is occurring. Someone took the bolts out of my gas tank, which fell out of my truck while driving. I was harassed and stalked so viciously that I was forced to flee my home for my life. I was stalked across the country, asking for help from every agency that I could think of, police in every state and gaslit by them all. I had to sell my truck in Texas, which I was living out of for a year, to afford a bus ticket home. I now have no vehicle, damages done to my home so that I am without running water and my boiler in disrepair. My home vandalized along with the stolen items. I am living in terror, trapped amongst the very individuals who have stalked and harassed Nick and I, with no way out. The terror is non stop. I do not deserve this, I have never done anything to anyone to be treated so viciously. Please contact me if you know of anyone that can and is willing to help me. 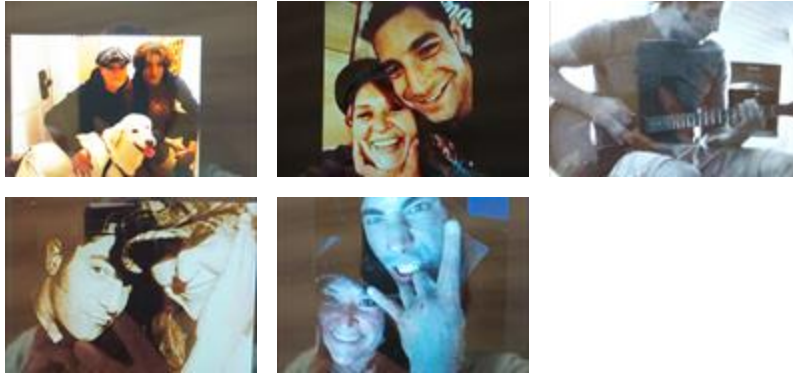

“ Today, on what would have been Nick's 35th birthday, I think of the day that he proposed to me. Not a decision that either of us took lightly and my love for him is enduring, as I know his is for me. I think back on the events that lead up to the day he died. The harassment that we were receiving from neighbors and how crucial it was for us to move as quickly as possible. The illegal surveillance that we were being put through, and which continues, as evidenced by me being approached repeatedly by strangers in stores giving me explicit details about my activities in my own home, such as what I cooked for dinner with details on how I cooked that meal, what I wore to bed and bathroom routines. Neighbors taunted Nick and have continued to do so to me. My mail has been stolen, including bank cards and statements and tax information and the police refuse to help. My phone and computer hacked. Many serious crimes that they refuse to investigate and gaslight me on. There were many times that we told others about the harassment and were gaslit repeatedly. When I made that vow to love Nick for the rest of my life, I meant it, and I am going to stand up for him knowing that he would still be alive today if we weren't attacked in the manner that I continue to be accosted in. I hope hope that someone here will see my messages and reach out to me. I sincerely am in need of help in finding representation to fight against the cruel and inhumane actions that took the love of my life from me. Please see my last post for my email. Nick was one of the most loving people that I have ever known and the truth needs to be known.

Nick and I told several family members about the harassment that we were experiencing, but we were gaslit, with statements that it wasn't as bad as we were saying. Since he has been gone, it has gotten so horrifying as neighbors have harassed me-one yelling out 'Yay, he's dead' to me, less than 2 weeks after he passed. Heckling me after coming home from his burial service, saying that I am now on the prowl, because I was dressed up. This individual also driving near my home stating that I should get out of the neighborhood, if I know what is good for me and calling me filthy names. This individual being one who regularly harassed Nick. The bolts in my gas tank were taken out, and my gas tank fell out of my truck while I was driving down the road. My home broken into with many items stolen and my home vandalized. Many strangers coming up to me and giving explicit details about what I was doing in my home. My mail being taken and many other crimes against me. I wish someone had listened to us. I wish he was still here. We were about to sell my house and buy a place to create a fly fishing lodge. I wish we had moved sooner. I don't understand why we were gaslit so badly and why it is still continuing for me. 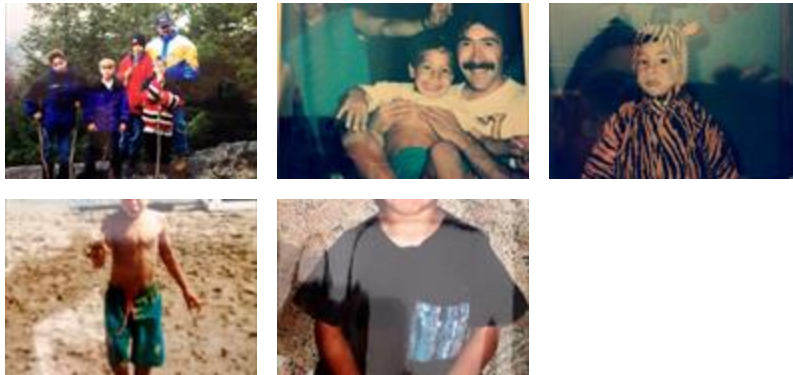
