Menands, NY-Patricia Ann Sabatino Caulfield 87, of Albany, New York passed away peacefully on February 14, 2026, surrounded by her loving family.

Born in Albany, New York in 1938, Pat is a graduate of Academy of the Holy Names and The College of St. Rose, which were the foundation of her professional life that was dedicated to education. She spent over 35 years shaping the minds of young children with patience, love, and creativity in Albany City Schools and St. Pius X School.

Her greatest legacy, however, was her own "classroom" at home where she instilled the values of love and her Catholic faith. life she was an active member of the Ladies of Charity.

Pat enjoyed spending time with people and created lifelong relationships. She surrounded herself with a large extended family along with neighborhood friends, high school and college friends, and teacher colleagues. Her monthly mahjong group and summer trips to the ocean with college friends were joyful memories.

Pat also enjoyed playing card games, board games, singing and creating songs for her kindergarten students, and along with her husband Tim, was the best jitterbug dancer on any dance floor.
