Loudonville-Patricia “Pat” A. Margiotta, 72, passed away peacefully on October 10th, after a brief, but courageous battle with pancreatic cancer. Born in Albany, NY, she was the daughter of the late Dominic and Margaret Maimone of Loudonville, NY.

Raised in West Albany, NY, Pat was a 1967 graduate of Colonie Central High School. Upon graduating from nursing school in 1969, Pat had a 35 year nursing career at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Albany. Following her retirement in 2004, Pat went on to work as a substitute nurse in the South Colonie School District for another 13 years. In her free time, Pat was an avid quilter and belonged to both the Q.U.I.L.T., Inc. and the Wing Falls Quilters Guilds. Throughout her lifetime, Pat greatly enjoyed traveling with her family and friends, making many return trips to Italy and Cocoa Beach, FL. Pat’s generosity with her family, friends, and her community was boundless. She will forever be remembered for her willingness to help, and for the countless quilts and knitted creations she gifted to loved ones and area organizations each year.

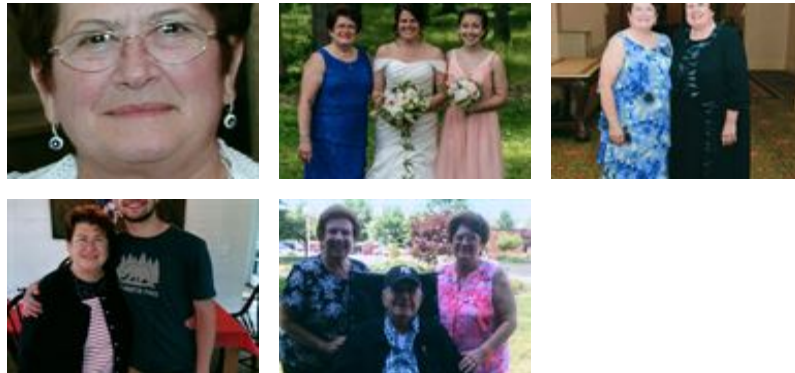
