Albany-Patricia H. McSweeney, 68, died Thursday, September 9, 2010 at home surrounded by her beloved family. Born in Brooklyn, she was the daughter of the late Elmer and Evangeline Shea Cuthbertson. Patricia retired from the Bethlehem School District where she was a food service worker.

She was a longtime, valuable and dedicated member of the Ladies Ancient Order of Hibernians JFK Division 1, where she currently serves as vice president. Patricia was a past LAOH Albany County President and past Business Manager of the Village Volunteers Fife and Drum Corps. She was a founder of the Trinity Degree Team, and founder and Volunteer Coordinator of the Irish 2000 Music and Arts Festival. Patricia also served as Aide to the Grand Marshall of the Albany St. Patrick's Day Parade.

Her family will cherish her example of dedication to both her faith, and Irish culture.

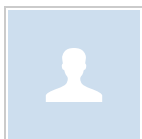
