Albany, NY-Paul R. Fuhrmann, 81, entered Eternal Life Wednesday, May 3, 2023, surrounded by loving family. Born in Lowville, NY, he was the son of the late Irving and Eleanor Lampman Fuhrmann.

Paul served in the US Army Airborne Division as a Paratrooper from 1961-64 before joining the Suffolk County Police Department where he retired as Detective Sergeant after 29 years of service.
