PAUL M. RUHL passed away peacefully on Saturday, May 9, 2015. Paul was born in Albany, NY on July 4, 1940. He was the son of the late Anna and Napoleon Ruhl. Former husband of the late Marie Ruhl (Horn) and brother to the late June (Ruhl) Barth, and father of Linda Smith Ruhl (Mitchell).

He attended St. John's School and graduated from Phillip Schuyler High School in 1957.

During his high school years he began his career with the Veterans Hospital. After graduating high school he was drafted into the US Army and served 4 years, two years he was stationed in Paris, France. Paul remained in the Army reserve for more than 30 years and retired as a Sergeant Major. In 1995 he retired Chief of Canteen Services at the VA Hospital in Canandaigua, NY.
