

Peter F. Rosenberger

March 30, 1945 - July 31, 2018

Colonie – Peter F. Rosenberger, 73, passed peacefully on July 31, 2018 in the comfort of his home with his loving family at his side.

Son of the late Henry V. and Pauline Harris Rosenberger, Peter was predeceased by his sisters Margie and Rita, brother Harry and infant son, John Henry.

He leaves behind his loving wife, Judy Kawiecki Rosenberger, his children, Peter Thomas (Wendi) of Colonie, Kimberly (Andy) of St. Louis, MO; his grandchildren Lauren, Ryan, Jack, Ben, and Carter; and his constant companion, Kitty-Kitty. He will also be greatly missed by his sister-in-law, Elizabeth Kelly, as well as his many nieces and nephews.

Pete was a 1963 graduate of Cardinal McCloskey High School, where he met and married his sweetheart and lifelong love, Judy.

The lights of his love were his family, who always had his undivided and constant attention. Pete's greatest gifts were his patience and his ability to strike up a conversation with anyone, strangers included. You were never a stranger for long, for Pete always made you feel like you were the only one in the room.

Pete was a printer starting at the age of 17 with the Schenectady Gazette, prior to establishing his own successful business, Techno Printing, where he provided service above and beyond what was expected. His clients always loved a visit from Pete, who was always upbeat and came carrying bagels, cookies, and sweets.

He was most recently employed by the Albany County Courthouse, where he worked in the judge's chambers. He was loved there as much as he loved working there.

He was an avid baseball fan of the San Francisco Giants (Go Giants!) and fierce supporter of the National Baseball Hall of Fame. He forged new friendships with a great many ball players, including Hall of Famers during his 35-year membership, volunteering to drive them to and from the airport, and showing them the local sites. His lifetime membership to the Hall of Fame was one of his most prized possessions, and one of only two items he kept in his wallet. He enjoyed nothing more than bringing a Boys' Club group to the Hall of Fame to give them the gift he so enjoyed.

Pete was also an avid bowler, a member of the Professional Bowlers Association, appearing on TV Tournament Time in the early 90's.

Pete was very social, always working the crowd at any event, enjoying family get togethers, Friday night pizza, and breakfast at Grandma's Pie Shop.

The family would like to extend their thanks and sincere gratitude to the Home Instead Senior Care who guided Judy expertly through this difficult time, and to The Community Hospice Foundation of Albany, both for their compassionate, tender care of Pete these last days. 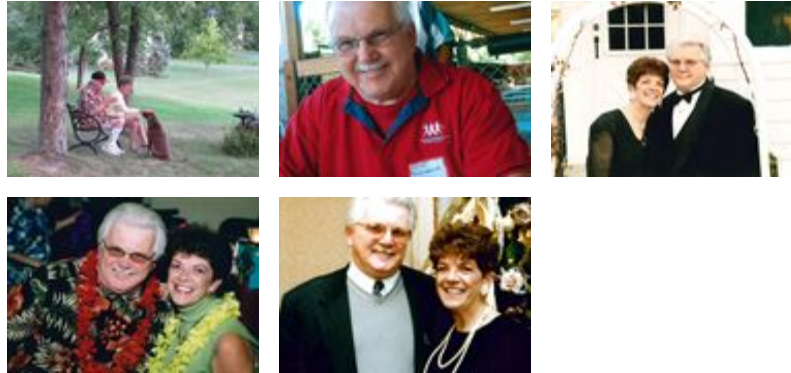

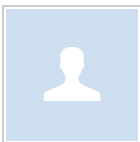
