January 5, 1914 - October 22, 2010

Albany-Philip T. DiPace, 96, died Friday, October 22, 2010 at Teresian House. Born in Albany and son of the late Bernardino and Grazia Gallotta DiPace. Phil was a US Army WW II veteran and served in the 78th Division Infantry. He fought in the Battle of the Bulge and in Belgium, Germany and England. He was a member of the American Legion, Colonie Elks and longtime communicant of Blessed Sacrament Church. He was the former owner of Modern Radio Shop, and Boiler Room Supervisor at Albany County Nursing Home.

Phil DiPace was a favorite Son of Albany, serving his beloved City of Albany for 32 years as an Alderman in the 12th Ward. He was originally sworn into office in 1970, and later also served as a Democratic Committeeman and President of the Albany Aldermanic Association.

He was the beloved husband of the late Alice McGowan DiPace; dear father of Grace Cordi (Vincent), Philip DiPace (Gloria), Claire Roberson (Carl), Alice Scott (Donald), Mary Sheridan (Patrick) and Joseph DiPace(Rebecca); brother of the late Edith Prewitt, Angelo , Ben, Anthony, Daniel and Leonard DiPace, Mary Lemme, Rose Gause, Ann MacCowan and Clare Vink; 17 grandchildren, 19 great grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews survive.
