June 27, 1925 - May 5, 2015

Albany - Raymond P. Lammers passed away peacefully at age 89 on May 5th at St. Peter's Hospital. He was born June 27, 1925 in Woodside, Queen, NY. He was the son of John J. Lammers and Gladys Banker Lammers.

He was predeceased by a brother John R. Lammers and sister Mary Ann Rowe.

He was a World War II veteran who proudly served in the U.S. Navy on the USS Tatum (APD 81). He retired after forty years of service from the New York State Dept. of Transportation. After his retirement he spent time volunteering on the Destroyer Escort Historical Museum, home to the USS Slater (DE 766) the last remaining destroyer escort afloat in the USA.

He was an accomplished artist, poet and writer and will be greatly missed by many.

He is survived by his dear friend Kate and the Fish family of Hudson, NY. Also surviving his sons Brent, David, James, Daniel, Thomas, a nephew John, daughters Beth, Susan and several grandchildren.

He will also be mourned by his Godson Donald and his lifelong friend Emma.

Funeral services Monday, May 11, 2015 at 10:30 am at Blessed Sacrament Church, Albany where a Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated. Relatives and friends are invited to attend.

Interment will follow the Mass at 1:30 pm in the Gerald B.H. Solomon Saratoga National Cemetery located in Schuylerville, New York in Saratoga County.
