May 30, 1916 - June 10, 2014

Albany-Raymond Joseph Lauterborn died Tuesday, June 10, 2014 in the Hospice Inn at St. Peter's Hospital. He was the husband of the late Mary Ann Banahan Lauterborn; father of Thomas J. Lauterborn (Joi), Kathleen Kearney (Edward), Susan J. Smith (Ronald) and M. Patrice Pahl (Jerald); brother of the late Kathleen Jarrett; survived by 12 grandchildren, and 15 great grandchildren who lovingly referred to him as "Grandpa Charlie."

Mr. Lauterborn was a 1934 graduate of Christian Brothers Academy, and he is recognized as one of the oldest living alumni of the school. He was a US Navy World War II veteran and was a member of the Rotterdam American Legion Post 1091.
