Albany-Reverend Anthony David Gulley, Ph.D., A.F.S.C., 83 years young, was born into Eternal Life Wednesday afternoon, August 21, 2013 unexpectedly at St. Peter's Hospital.

Fr. Gulley was the cherished brother of Rev. James C. Gulley (retired Pastor of St. Mary's Church, Amsterdam) and the late Joseph G. Gulley, John A. Gulley, and Marie Gulley Phillips; brother -in-law of Katherine Gulley; beloved friend to the Parente, McVeigh, Healey and Dwyer families; Fr. Gulley is survived by many nephews and nieces.
