Loudonville- Dr. Richard H. Hall, recently of Turner Lane in Loudonville, passed away on September 23rd, 2015. Born October 6th, 1934 in Philadelphia, PA. to the late Edwin and Carol Van Bolt Hall.

Professor Hall was the Distinguished Professor of Sociology at the University at Albany, where he taught from 1977 to 2007, in addition to serving as Vice President, Dean and Department Chair at various times. Dr. Hall was also the University's faculty advisor to the athletic department during U Albany's transition to Division I athletics and is a member of the University's athletic hall of fame. He had previously taught at the Universities of Minnesota, Vermont and Indiana after receiving his Ph. D. from Ohio State University.

He was a member of the board for the Albany Symphony Orchestra and of the Willard Mountain Ski Patrol.

He is survived by his loving wife Sherry; his son, Tom Hall (Maribeth) and daughter Julie Dinneen (Miles); his brother George and four grandchildren, Heath, Kate, Lily and Bridget.

A celebration of Richard Hall's life will be held at the Alumni House at the University at Albany at 10 am on Friday, October 23.
