Albany-Robert E. Warner, Jr, passed away on April 29, 2015. He was born on January 5, 1931, in Albany, NY. He was the son of the late Robert E. Warner Sr. and Katherine Doran Warner. Robert served as a Sergeant in the Army, in the Korean War, from 1952 to 1955. He worked as a lineman for Niagara Mohawk for 42 years with his final 12 years as a Right-of-Way Agent, a job which he truly enjoyed. He was a union man who had a company job. He was in the union for a total of 60 years. After his retirement from Nimo, he was employed for 16 years at Anthony's Chocolate Dipped Fruit Company.
