Albany-Robert J. Huba died Wednesday, October 24, 2012 at home surrounded by his family. Robert was one of ten children born to the late William and Mary Bigley Huba.

Mr. Huba was a member of the Nocturnal Adoration Society of Albany as well as a member of the Elks Lodge #49, The American Legion Post 1610, and a former Director of the Board of the Albany Boys Club.

He was an original trustee of the Wolferts Roost Caddy Scholarship Fund and the first president of the Blessed Sacrament Home School Association.

He was known as "Pop" and "Big D" to his family. He was a true patriarch and felt his greatest achievement was his family.

He was a devoted grandpa, husband, father and patriot and will be so dearly missed.
