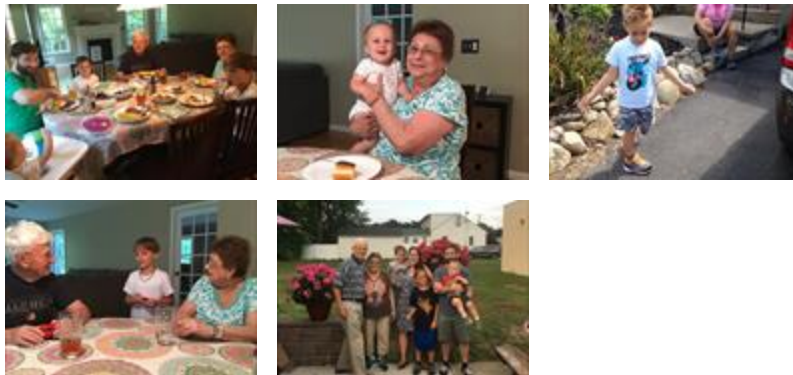

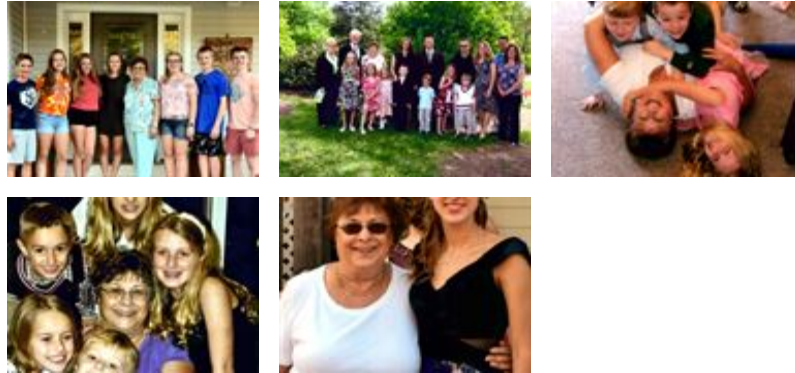


So heart broken to hear about Rosalie's passing. She (and Bill) were like Grandparents to our children and we were so lucky to not only know her but to love her and be loved by her.

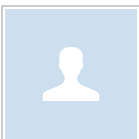
