Colonie-Rosanne Caccese of Colonie passed away on Monday May 2, 2016 after a courageous year long battle with cancer. She was at home surrounded by family that loved her deeply and will miss her terribly. Rosanne was born in Brooklyn, NY on September 21, 1948; she was the beloved daughter of Anne (DiConza) Morano and the late Philip Morano.

She graduated from Our Lady of Perpetual Help High School and earned her degree as a Registered Nurse from the Methodist School of Nursing. Rosanne married the love of her life Albert Caccese in October of 1973 and moved to Colonie in 1976 where she spent the better part of 30 years as a nurse at Albany Memorial Hospital.

Rosanne loved spending time with her family and friends; she enjoyed theater, shopping (for herself and everyone else) and travel, especially her trips to NYC and Europe. She had a strong faith and was an active member of the Roman Catholic Church. 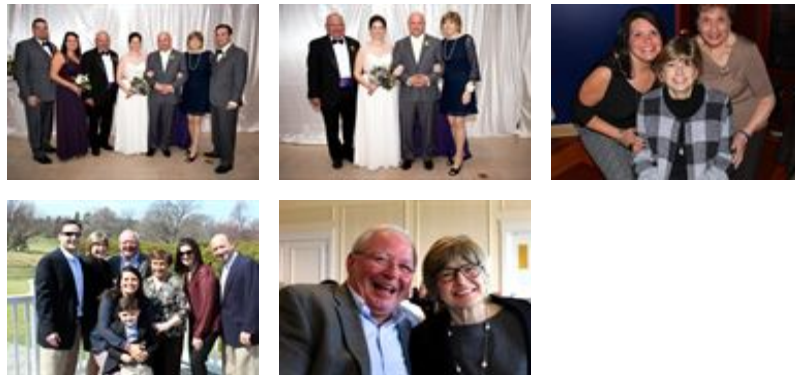
