Albany, NY-Rose L. Arduini, 90, was Born into Eternal Life Easter Sunday, March 31, 2013 at her home. Born in Albany, she was the daughter of the late Frank and Bridget Salvaggio Pagliuco. She was a homemaker.

A 1940 graduate of Vincentian Institute, Rose had worked for the General Electric during WWII, and then the New York Telephone Company until 1957. In 1968, she became one of the first school “lunch ladies” at West Albany School, where she loved working with the students. She was also the first female usher at the former St. Francis de Sales Church, now called Christ Our Light Catholic Church. Rose was known for her excellent cooking and baking. She enjoyed dancing and she and Ben often cleared the floor jitterbugging. She loved clothes shopping and in her later years, she enjoyed flower gardening with her daughter, Diane.
