Albany-Ruth Cecilia Keane Daley died Saturday November 28, 2015 at the Home of the Good Shepherd in Malta NY after a long illness. 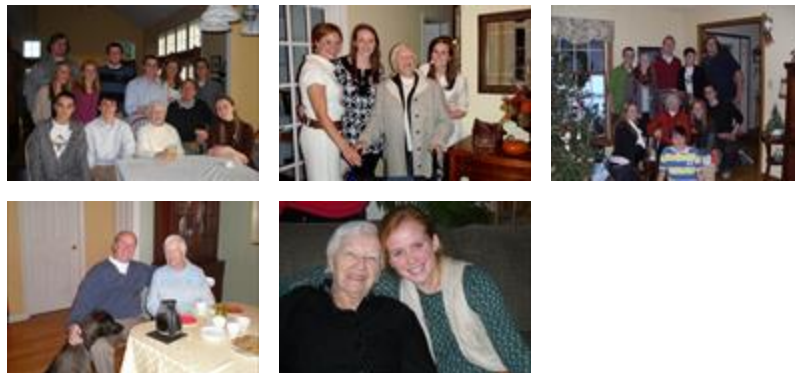

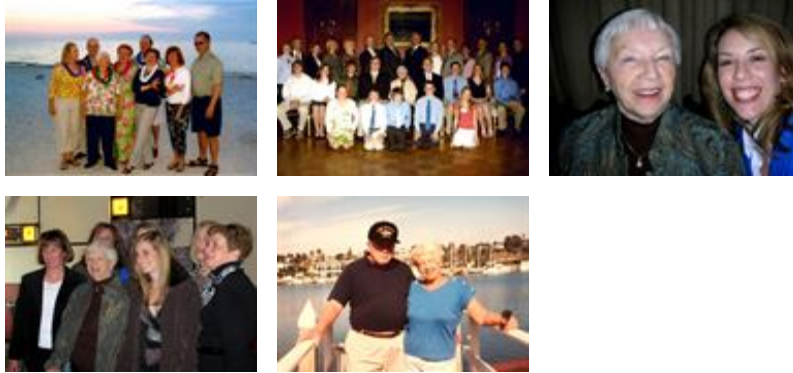
