March 16, 1931 - November 4, 2012

Albany-Salvatore G. DiCarlo, 81, died Sunday, November 4, 2012 in the Hospice Inn at St. Peter's Hospital. Born in Albany, Sal was the son of the late Giuseppe and Mary Strano DiCarlo. He was a US Army Korean War Veteran. Sal was the longtime owner and proprietor of DiCarlo's Gentlemen's Club on Central Avenue, which was formerly known as September's and then the Backstage.

He was the 33 year companion of Barbara Sammon, and her children Robert Sammon Jr and Heather Sammon; brother of Mary Coluccio (Tony) and Mario DeCarlo; uncle of Paul Coluccio (Lisa), Joe Coluccio (Dawn), Tony Coluccio and Anthony DeCarlo; father of Gary DiCarlo, Mary June DiCarlo, Sharyn DiCarlo and Joann DiCarlo; he is also survived by grandchildren, grandnieces and grandnephews.
