



## Scott Wayne Lundstedt

February 9, 1946 - June 23, 2014

Guilderland- Scott Wayne Lundstedt, 68, passed away June 23, 2014 surrounded by his family. Born February 9, 1946 in Jamaica, Long Island, NY he was the son of the late Jack H. and Helen L. Howell Lundstedt.

Scott graduated from Harbor Fields High School in Centerport, LI and Alfred University in Elmira, NY, where he participated in the ROTC. He was a veteran of the Army, having served in Germany until 1969, and then served in the New York National Guard until 1995. After retiring from the National Guard he worked for the RPEA (Retired Public Employees Association). He was a volunteer for the Community Caregivers, and a member of the Lynnwood Reformed Church in Guilderland.

He was a loving husband, father and grandfather who enjoyed traveling, sailing and made family a priority. He was always willing to help others.

Scott was the beloved husband of Sandra Lundstedt of Guilderland, NY; cherished father of Justin Lundstedt and his wife Joanne of Wappingers Falls, NY and Sonja Mazzulli and her husband Christopher of East Lyme, Ct; grandfather of Jeffrey, Grace and Christopher Lundstedt, Tucker, Auserehl and Aneleise Mazzulli. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brother Jeffrey Lundstedt.

A memorial service will be held Thursday, July 3, 2014 at 10:30 am at the Lynnwood Reformed Church, 3714 Carman Rd., Schenectady, NY.

Following a reception in the church, graveside services will be held at the Gerald B.H. Solomon Saratoga National Cemetery, Schuylerville at 2:30 pm. Relatives and friends are invited to attend.
