Always an avid traveler, in recent years she went on an African safari and took trips to Japan and China.

She was predeceased by her husband of 49 years, John J. Sheridan in 2008.

Shirley was recently predeceased by her son Kevin D. Sheridan. She is survived by her daughter Kathleen Rissberger (Thomas) of Loudonville, NY; her daughter-in-law Dodee Sheridan (Kevin) of Clifton Park, her granddaughters Caitlin, Courtney and Carly Sheridan and great granddaughter Elizabeth, all of Clifton Park, NY; her sister Joyce Doig of The Villages, Florida and her brother Dewayne McOsker (Mary) of Port St. Lucie, Florida.
