



Sister Agnes Patricia Driscoll

March 31, 1934 - February 27, 2011

Albany-Sr. Agnes Patricia Driscoll, a Carmelite Sister for the Aged and Infirm for 59 devoted years, died Sunday, February 27, 2011 at Teresian House.

Born in Philadelphia, PA she was the daughter of the late Joseph and Marie Clayton Driscoll. Sister spent her dedicated years of ministry as a register nurse in the various facilities operated by the Carmelite Sisters.
