



Stillman Donald "Don" Pitts

Rexford, NY-Stillman Donald Pitts ("Don"), born on January 8, 1931, in Albany, New York, passed away on August 9, 2024. He was the cherished son of the late Stillman Miller Pitts and Katherine Snyder and spent his early years in the Capital Region until 1952, when he began his lifetime of adventure.

Don was the beloved husband of his high school sweetheart, the late Flora Adele Stodart, with whom he shared 67 years and a lifetime of cherished memories. A proud graduate of Christian Brothers Academy, Don went on to earn a Bachelor's Degree in Metallurgy from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. a lifelong passion for gardening, with a particular talent for cultivating blueberries. He was a lifelong learner, always curious and asking questions about anything new to him. A voracious reader, Don also found great satisfaction in studying and trading on the stock market. In his later years, he discovered a love of baking, especially crafting delicious pies.

Don and Flora shared a love of travel, embarking on adventures that took them across Europe, South America, Australia, and the Caribbean. An accomplished boater and sailor, Don loved his time on the water, where he felt the most at ease. Above all, Don treasured his family and friends, holding them close in his heart and fondly recalling the many memories they shared. Don's life was marked by his dedication to his family, his work, and his diverse interests, leaving behind a legacy of love, intellect, and quiet accomplishment.

Don was predeceased by his wife, Flora, his parents, his sister Nancy Osterhaut, and most recently his son in law Jim Stilwell. 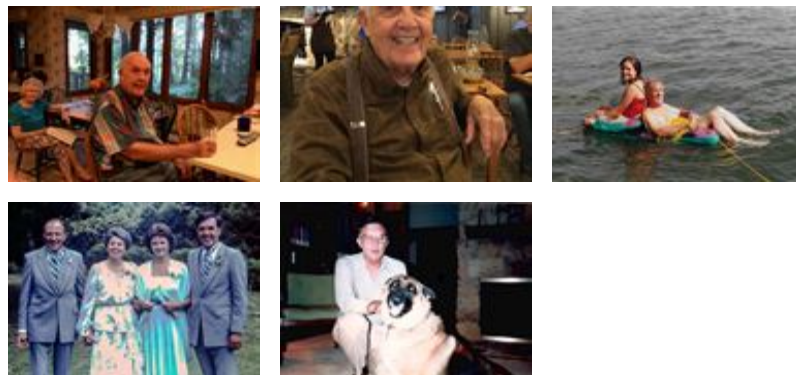
