



## Teresa V. Malone

December 29, 1923 - January 10, 2012

Albany-Teresa V. Malone, 88, lifelong resident of Albany, NY died Tuesday, January 10, 2012.

Teresa was born on December 29, 1923 to Rose Allegretti and Louis Vignola. She was predeceased by her devoted husband James Q. Malone.

She graduated from Cathedral High School in 1941 and from The College of St. Rose in 1945. She worked as a registered nurse and retired from the Veteran's Administration Hospital as supervisor of nursing. Teresa was the 2009 recipient of the Carondelet Lifetime Achievement Award and was an active volunteer for numerous groups and committees at her college alma mater. She was a member of the St. Peter's Hospital Auxiliary, The College of St. Rose Alumni Association, Albany Council of Catholic Nurses, Catholic Daughters of America, the 1941 Cathedral "lunch bunch", the St. Teresa of Avila Ladies Guild, the St. Margaret Mary's and All Saints Seniors and in her retirement was a dedicated teacher's aide at the former Holy Cross School. She was an avid lover of The College of St. Rose Golden Knights Basketball teams, having attended virtually every home game from 1994- 2010.

Survivors include her children Judith M. Reynolds (Keith), Jim Malone (Ann), her three grandchildren Shaun Reynolds (Carly), Kimberly Reynolds (Brendan Hoffman) and Tara Rose Malone; and three great grandchildren Matthew and

Jillian Reynolds and CJ Hoffman. Also survived by her beloved sister Phyllis Caraynoff and her devoted friend and neighbor Barbara Micare as well as a large, loving extended family.
