Albany, NY-Theresa "Terri" M. Bronner, 83, entered Eternal Life Friday, October 18, 2024 at her home in Albany, NY.

She was born in Albany on June 1, 1941, the daughter of David E. Bronner Sr and Marjorie Bronner.

Terri was a graduate of The Albany Academy for Girls, Class of 1959. She attended Manhattanville College of the Sacred Heart in Purchase, NY and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in 1963. Terri later studied at Russell Sage College and received a Master's Degree in Social Sciences. She served as a nun in The Sacred Heart Order teaching at the former Kenwood Academy in Albany, She also taught at the Sacred Heart Academy in Grosse Point, MI. Terri later served in the Sisters for the Christian Community and taught in St. Clements School in Saratoga Springs, NY. She also was a contract employee for many years with New York State Department of Mental Health. Terri was a communicant of St. Vincent DePaul Church in Albany, NY, where she was very active in the church community helping to care for the sick and underprivileged. Terri was an artist who enjoyed painting pictures of various scenes. She also enjoyed traveling throughout the United States, Canada and Europe.

Terri is survived by two brothers, David E. Bronner Jr (Angelika) and Kevin M. Bronner Sr (Karen); a niece Michelle I. Bronner and nephews David Bronner
