He was like a big brother and hero to me, and for some reason he let me hang around with him, when he was around 11 and 12 years old. Maybe he wanted to see what it was like to have a little brother. Tod was a pretty good catcher and hitter in Little League and I used to go to his games at the old Westland Hills field (Colvin Merchants). He would also take me around all kinds of places on his bike and I remember throwing snowballs at trucks and other shenanigans in the winter, and the big backyard at the Mulrooney's house with the rope on the tree for swinging. Of course there was a price to pay to hang out with the big kids, such as the time he set off a firecracker in my back pocket while I was sitting in front of him on his bike! I remember him laughing all the time and being a fun kid to be around. Soon, Tod became a teen and discovered girls and I didn't get to see him much. I would see him occasionally over the years, but we were never close like that again. But I always will have the childhood memories of my big brother.
