Albany-Victor C. Rauch, 90, entered Eternal Life Friday, September 23, 2016 at St. Peter's Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. Born in Albany, he was the son of the late Frederick and Margaret Boyle Rauch.

Victor was a US Army WW II veteran, serving with the 592nd Field Artillery Battalion of the 106 Golden Lion Infantry Division during the Battle of the Bulge. His unit was able to escape the encirclement of the division by the Germans and they continued the fight with the 18th Airborne Corp. Victor received 4 Battle Stars.

He attended Russell Sage College and retired from the Internal Revenue Service.

He was the uncle of Deborah Dollery (late Brian t. Dollery), Ruth Dollery, Patrick Hughes Sr (Ann Marie) and other nieces and nephews.
