Albany-Vincent Paul Campbell, Jr. passed away on February 1, 2017, surrounded by his loving family.

Vincent was born August 30, 1943 in Albany, NY to the late Vincent and Helen (Lewis) Campbell. Vince attended Christian Brothers Academy and graduated from Rochester Institute of Technology, where he was a member of Phi Sigma Kappa.

Vince served the United States Army during the Vietnam War, stationed in Okinawa, Japan. His wife joined him and they had their first child there. Upon his return to the States, Vince embarked in a career in business, working for Heinz and B.F. Goodrich before starting his own business, C&S Tire, on North Allen Street in Albany.

Vince went on to work as the science labs coordinator for the Albany City School District before his retirement. Vince enjoyed cross country skiing, boating on Lake George, camping, dining out - especially Italian food - and hopping in the car to visit friends and family. Vince had a magnetic personality and touched the hearts of everyone he met. An eternal optimist, Vince was a fighter till the very end.

He is predeceased by his wife Sandra (Steede) Campbell with whom he

shared 38 years of marriage, and his sister in law Margaret Kaufman.
