Voorheesville-Vincent Nicotina, 82, died Monday, January 19, 2015 in the Hospice Inn at St. Peter's Hospital with his loving family present. Born in Rina, Province of Messina, Italy, Vincent was the son of the late Santo and Rachela Miuccio Nicotina.

Vincent was educated in Sicily, and graduated from Philip Schuyler High School. He came to America in 1949, and after school went on to serve his Country during the Korean War in the US Army.
