October 6, 1921 - March 5, 2015

Glenmont-William J. Mooney, 93, longtime resident of Glenmont died Thursday, March 5, 2015 surrounded by his loving family at St. Peter's Hospital. He was born October 6, 1921 in Rensselaer to Daniel and Mary Reilly Mooney.

He was a weaver at Huyck Felt Co for 45 years. Bill was an avid NY Yankee and NY Giants fan. He was a US Army Veteran of WW II. Bill attended St. John's School, Rensselaer. He was a volunteer and charter member of the Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance Service and a 60 year active charter member of Selkirk Volunteer Fire Department #2.

Bill recently retired after 13 years from volunteering as a driver for St. John's-St. Ann's Outreach Center Food Pantry.

He was the beloved husband of Laverna "Lee" Cupps Mooney for 67 years; much loved father of Sandra (Timothy) O'Keefe, James W. (Rita) Mooney; devoted grandfather of James (Tara) O'Keefe, Collin (Amanda) Mooney, and Caitlin (Michael) Ryan; special Papa Mooney to great grandson Liam O'Keefe; brother of the late Mary (George) Sedgwick; also survived by many nieces and nephews.

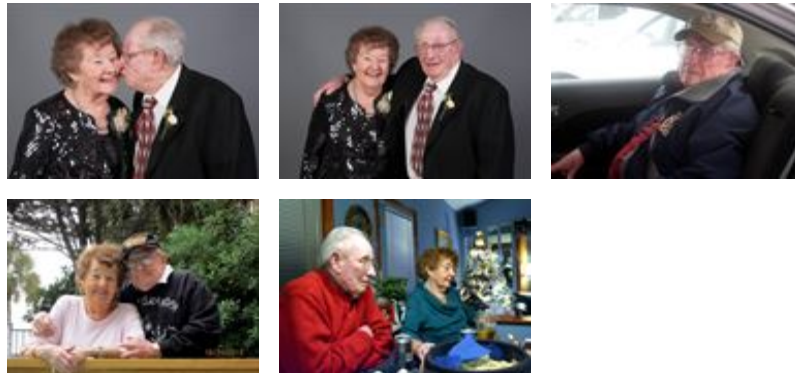
