Albany-William C. Matulewicz, died January 20, 2010 at Teresian House. Born in Albany, the son of the late Stanley and Antonia Petritis Matulewicz. He lived in Guilderland Center most of his life, moving to Albany in 1991. Bill was a US Army WW II veteran, serving in the European and Pacific Theaters. He was a heavy equipment operator for the Department of the Army, and then for the Department of the Naval Research at Seneca Lake. He later worked for the chairman and commissioners of the NYS Public Service Commission. He was a charter member of the VFW Post 7062 in Altamont, and communicant of the former Holy Cross Church.

He was the brother of the late Stanley and Edward Matulewicz, Stella Aldridge and Berniece Tremel; uncle of Dolores (Joseph) Van Noske and three nephews; also survived by several close friends who were with him through his long illness, they are Eva Wesselmann and her family, Carla Brind, Mabel Murphy, and David Sowalsky.
